Actor

A native of Guizhou, Dunn was born in Hong Kong and fell in love with acting at a young age. His father, Larry Dunn, sent him to an audition organised by Motion Picture and General Investment Co Ltd (MP & GI) when he was seven. His talent impressed director Griffin Yue Feng who cast him in *Our Beloved Son* (1959). He then acted in a series of MP & GI films, including *For Better, For Worse* (1959), *Education of Love* (1961), *Father and Son* (1963) and *Father Takes a Bride* (1963). Dunn's acting career ended when he entered secondary school. His younger brother, Paul Dunn, was also a child actor.

Dunn later studied media studies at University of Georgia and Temple University. He founded *City Magazine* with Henry Wu, Joseph Yau and John Chan in 1976. He left *City Magazine* in 1983 and has since been helping his father to manage the family business.
