



SUN Jinsan 孫晉三 (1914–1962.8.30)

Screenwriter

A graduate of Tsinghua University, Sun furthered his studies in drama at Harvard University after being granted the Boxer Indemnity for overseas education. He went on a study tour in the US and Europe before returning to the Mainland to become a professor of drama and foreign literature at Nanjing Central University. Apart from teaching, he was also the chief editor for the arts and literature magazine, *Time and Tide*.

In 1955, upon the invitation of International Films Distributing Agency (later restructured as Motion Picture and General Investment Co Ltd [MP & GI]), Sun joined the company as one of four members of the screenwriting committee. During this period, Sun penned the critically acclaimed *Till the End of Time* (1961), directed by the famous Evan Yang. On 30 August 1962, Sun passed away of illness in Hong Kong at the age of 48.
